ADDENDUM

Expression of Interest (EoI) from Reputed Government/ Semi Government Educational/ Technical/ Research Institutions/ Companies (Govt/ semi Govt) were invited by advertisement for carrying out Gap Analysis Study for Bio-Medical Waste Generation and Treatment in the state of Uttarakhand. Pre-Bid meeting was held on 05.07.2024 at 11:00 AM in the Head Office. Considering the recommendation of the committee following amendments are being made in the Expression of Interest: -

- Para 17(i) is replaced and read as follows: - Only registered, bonafide & Government/Semi Government Educational/Technical/Research Institutions/ Companies (Government/ Semi Government) having experience in conducting the gap analysis of waste generations and its management & similar works related to waste management including filed survey in the at least five (5) years need only apply. The Applicant shall submit the documentary evidences like, Work Orders, Performance Certificates, etc. along with the bid.
- To remove ambiguity and confusion Committee recommended to omit the para 17(ii) of the EoI document.
- Para 17(iii) is replaced and read as follows: - The bidding Institute shall have the sufficient numbers on roll scientific and technical staff to carry proposed study.

Head of the projected so appointed shall have following minimum qualification:

- (i) Post Graduate in Engineering/ Science in Environment/ Chemical/ Bio Chemical. Candidate having Doctorate in the respective field will be an added advantage.

OR

M.B.B.S. Degree. Post Graduate in medicine/Community medicine, or PG Diploma in Hospital Waste management will be an added advantage.


- (ii) At least 10 years of work experience in the field of waste management studies.

The bidding Institute shall submit the list of staff, names, qualifications, experience, etc. and documentary proofs while submitting the bid.

Details of Project Head and other staff proposed to be allocated for the said study shall be provided in the format placed at enclosure-2. Kindly note that the other staff shall be technical in nature and must have at least graduate in science/ engineering.

- New para in the section 17 is being added as 17 (viii) which is read as follows: Applicant must have digital monitoring tool for monitoring for day-to-day work of the assignment and access of the same shall be given to SPCB.
- Para-6 is replaced and read as follows: -
 - a. No advance payment will be given for start of the work.
 - b. 10 % of the contract value will be released to the Applicant after successful completion of preliminary report. Preliminary report shall include submission of primary and secondary data (at least list of different type of HCFs in different districts)
 - c. 20% of the contract value will be released to the Applicant after submission of the data related to waste generation from each HCFs
 - d. 20% of the contract value shall be released to the Applicant after submission of the data pertaining to CBWTFs.
 - e. 20% of the contract value shall be released to the Applicant after submission of interim report.
 - f. Balance 30 % of the contract value will be released after acceptance of final report.
- Last date of Document Submission shall be 27.07.2024. Technical specifications opening date & time shall be 01.08.2024.

Other terms and conditions of the document will remain same.
